



QUALITY REQUIREMENTS FOR PANEL WOOD, FIREWOOD

Wood must be made of pine, spruce, alder, aspen and alder or comply with LST-1997:2009.

We do not accept:

- Birch and hardwood timber,
- Charred, dirty wood or wood with mineral impurities inserts,
- Wood with rot,
- Wood with the central rot or hollow larger than 1/3 of the diameter.

Length and thickness:

- Separate small logs length – 2; 2.5 or 3 meters. Each stack may not have different lengths of logs.
- Separate small logs thickness must be between 6 cm in the thin end up to 60 cm in the thickest part.

Other requirements:

- Dead wood can comprise up to 20% of the total lot size.
- Roundwood is accepted by the group measurement.
- The precision rate for 2 meters deciduous wood panels – 0.65; four 3 meters of timber – 0.61. For Coniferous wood panels, the rate is increased by 0.03. If the number of curved small logs is in excess of 25% of flat timber or pulpwood consignment – the rate is reduced by 0.07.
